Canadian Sport Institute Calgary (CSI Calgary) is seeking applications for volunteer Board positions from individuals that are interested in serving as a Director of the CSI Calgary.

The CSI Calgary Board of Directors is a governance Board. Governance excellence requires members who can think conceptually and with a long-term perspective, and who are able to welcome a wide range of opinions. The Nominating Committee is seeking applications from interested candidates to join this dynamic group of leaders.

The Nominating Committee encourages applications from different sectors and with diverse backgrounds. The Nominating Committee is seeking applicants who are working in a range of roles – finance, revenue generation, government relations, sport sector, communications, technology, and social media are considered assets.

Directors are expected to commit the necessary time and expertise required to perform Board and Committee responsibilities. As a minimum, the CSI Calgary has three (3) Board meetings per year (4 hours each) and 2-3 conference calls (1 hour each) plus Committee work.

The CSI Calgary is designed to give high performance athletes and their coaches a physical, psychological and competitive edge. The CSI Calgary approaches its business from the athlete and coach perspective, building on Calgary's highly successful training environment to provide athletes with the tools to thrive, both competitively and personally. While podium performance is the goal, the CSI Calgary's long-term objective is the development of athletes as individuals and as community leaders.

CSI Calgary Board members must have a clear understanding of, and competence to deal with, the current and emerging issues of the core business (and related businesses) and can effectively review and challenge the performance of management and exercise independent judgement.
